About Us

The mission of Skyview is to help people come to know Christ and to grow in Him. We are a vibrant and growing church with a weekly worship attendance of 120 people from various backgrounds and stages of life. We are currently in the process of building our first church facility in the northwest community of Harvest Hills in the city of Calgary. We anticipate moving in to our new worship space by the summer of 2018.

We are a member of the Church of the Nazarene, an international denomination with close to 2.5 million members worldwide. As a local church we are committed to making disciples and consider the development of Missional Communities an essential means to accomplishing this task.

Job purpose

The purpose of this role is to implement, grow, and manage the ministry of 'Missional Communities' within the Skyview church family. Missional Communities are groups of people formed around a common focus, a shared passion or area of interest who gather regularly to learn, grow and serve together.

Duties and responsibilities

The primary role of the pastor will be to provide leadership and direction to the (MC) missional community ministry. She/he will:

- Recruit, train and develop competent and effective MC leaders
- Identify existing opportunities for MC formation as well as discern opportunities for establishing new ones
- Serve as a resource person and mentor to leaders of missional communities
- Hold MC leaders accountable to the core values of Skyview focusing upon learning, growing and serving together
- Connect newcomers to existing missional communities
- Provide opportunities for the church to hear stories of missional community ministry and outreach on a regular basis
- Develop and manage a ministry budget for MC's
- Meet weekly with the Sr. Pastor for accountability, input, and prayer
- Report to the board on a monthly basis on the progress, challenges and opportunities within this ministry
- Regular attendance of Sunday worship services

Qualifications

The appropriate candidate will exhibit a personal and vibrant life of faith in Jesus Christ. She/he will be a mature Christian whose love for God is made evident in their relationship to others. Such a person's life must be marked by the presence and fruit of God's Holy Spirit, clear leadership ability and spiritual maturity a necessity.

- Masters or Bachelors Degree/ theology preferred
- Prior experience in local church ministry preferred

- The successful candidate will be provided with a laptop, partial administrative support, a monthly cellphone allowance and scheduled access to the church office which she/he will share with the Sr. Pastor.
- The sharing of office space will be a temporary arrangement until the construction of our new church facility is completed.
