



SUMMER MINISTRY POSITION

Glamorgan Church, Calgary, AB

Glamorgan Church, affiliated with the Church of God Anderson Indiana, is looking to fill a full-time summer ministry position. We are a small church with approximately 100 to 120 attendees on Sunday mornings. This summer position will provide you with an excellent opportunity to gain experience and understanding of ministry and life in a small church. The primary responsibility of the summer ministry position is to work closely with the Associate pastor to ensure summer ministry events occur and that tasks related to fall ministry start-up are completed. This job is dependent upon receiving Canada Summer Grant approval.

Dates: May 8th or 15th, 2017 to August 25th, 2017 (15/16 weeks)
Pay: \$15.00 hour; plus 4% vacation pay
Hours: 40 / week (Monday to Friday and some weekend work is required)
Deadline: Applications are accepted until April 21st

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in preparation, coordination and execution of youth events in May and June.
- Participate in monthly 55+ Ministry luncheon (May/June)
- Assist in preparation of and participate in Annual Stampede Breakfast (July)
- Preparation of fall curriculum for children's Sunday morning teaching (includes: script writing, lesson planning, painting, supply organization).
- Assist in planning and preparation of Mission trip within Alberta
- Preparation for Summer VBS (includes stage, prop and/or decoration preparation)
- Attend summer youth and children's camp as a counselor or in any other role needed by the camp
- Participate in VBS as a small group or station leader
- Provide office support during summer vacation schedule and assist with weekly bulletin and other communication documents
- Dependent on applicant's interests further ministry opportunities may be available.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- **Leadership Skills:** Assume responsibility for assigned tasks; work productively; work in a team; and, able to work independently and cooperatively with minimal supervision
- **Personal Skills:** Love of children/youth, team player, responsible, accountable, friendly, enthusiastic, good time management, and committed to Christian values and principles.
- **Student:** Between the ages of 18 and 30. Full-time student in previous academic year and intending to return to school on a full-time basis in next academic year.
- **Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or have official refugee protection status** under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act; and be legally entitled to work in Canada, according to relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.
