To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Kyle Meeker, and I direct the Northview Internship Program. I am excited that this program is entering its tenth year. The program is designed for senior college students and recent grads. Through this program, emerging leaders grow and develop through hands on ministry experience and weekly teaching sessions. The program is 10 months long, starting in September. It is primarily designed to provide the opportunity for each intern to discern whether or not they are called to serve the local church in full-time vocational ministry. It's a place to put education into practice and a safe environment to grow through successes and failures. Over the course of the internship, there will be approximately 60 hours of theological teaching and approximately 36 hours of other ministry related classes. Interns will visit a number of the ministries within the campuses of our church to see how we strive to live out our Core Values in a variety of settings. The internship is a 40-hour a week position that will provide a stipend of \$1200 per month to allow the intern to focus entirely on the internship without having to work outside the church. There are no costs associated with the program. Everything needed to participate in this program will be provided at no cost to interns (eg. textbooks, office space, supplies, etc.).

Each intern will receive a ministry placement in one of our church's departments, and will spend the ministry year gaining experience with that department. Ministry placements are decided by the program director based on the ministry intentions of the intern and the suitability of placements available. The majority of an intern's time is spent in this placement. The other portion of their internship is spent in the classes and visits mentioned above.

We have enclosed the promotional poster of our program as well as some brochures outlining the above, and detailing the application process.
